DIVERSITY VISITING CLERKSHIP PROGRAM

The Office of Health Equity, Diversity and Inclusion at Temple University's Lewis Katz School of Medicine announces its **Diversity Visiting Clerkship Program**. Fourth-year medical students interested in working in an urban, underserved area are invited to apply.

Who Should Apply

The grant is available to full-time medical students in good standing at LCME-accredited United States medical schools who are United States citizens. Priority will be given to individuals who are historically underrepresented in medicine .

Length

All clerkships are four weeks in length.

Courses Offered

Currently rotations are available in Emergency Medicine, Internal Medicine, Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery, and Radiation Oncology.

Housing

The program provides housing for participating students, subject to availability.

Financial Assistance

- Reimbursement of up to \$500 toward travel costs
- Reimbursement of the VSAS application processing fee (\$300)

How to Apply

- Complete VSAS application
- Personal statement (350-500 words) discussing career goals submitted to OHEDI@temple.edu (or submitted via facsimile at 215-707-4725)
- One faculty letter of recommendation
