Program Overview

Summer Intensive Program – 10 weeks starting June 1 – August 4, 2023

- 10-week stipend
- Offered in-person, virtual, and hybrid formats for participants for Summer 2023.
- Targeted skills and knowledge building through seminars and workshops in US and SSA.
- Mentored research and hands-on experience with research faculty member conducting global mental health disparities research in Sub-Saharan Africa or the US.
- Mentorship team and international network building.

Eligibility

Summer Intensive Program

- Advanced predoctoral students working towards degrees such as MD, PhD, EdD, PharmD, ScD, OTD, etc.
- Postdocs, residents, fellows, or early-career researchers/junior faculty within 5 years of terminal degree.
- US citizen, non-citizen national, or permanent US resident.
- From an underrepresented or disadvantaged group in biomedical, behavioral, clinical, and social science research.
- Commitment to global health disparities research.
