The Department of Surgery at Washington University in St. Louis welcomes applications to our Diversity Sub-internship Program intended to increase underrepresented minority interest in academic surgery. The Program will provide accepted sub-intern students with a four-week rotation at Washington University between July and October in General Surgery or any of its subspecialties.

The Program will provide campus housing adjacent to the rotation site, as well as a \$1500.00 stipend to help offset the cost of flights, fees, and incidental expenses.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Diversity Sub-Internship Program is designed to give students with a diverse background the experience of rotating as a surgical sub-intern at Washington University in St. Louis Department of Surgery. The sub-intern will function in the role of a surgical intern and will be required to attend all conferences including core curriculum, morbidity and mortality conference, rotation-based clinical case conferences and simulation lab experiences with the house staff.

WHO SHOULD APPLY

The Program is open to applicants who belong to groups that are recognized as historically underrepresented in the health profession including African American, American Indian, Alaska Native, Hispanic American and Pacific Islander and/or LGBTQIA. The sub-internship is four weeks in duration and will only be offered between July and October. Students must be enrolled in their final year of medical school in good academic standing at an LCME-accredited medical school, and have completed all required core clerkships. Students will be accepted into clinical rotations only if space is available during the preferred time period. In addition, all students must meet requirements set forth by the Washington University School of Medicine for all visiting students. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A brief statement of interest (250-word limit), one letter of recommendation, curriculum vitae, USMLE scores, a photo, and a recent unofficial medical school transcript should be submitted by May 15, 2018 via email at asksurgery@wustl.edu. Decisions will be made by June 15, 2018.
